Flag Retirement Services are being offered by Troop 346 of Minnetonka, Minnesota.

Flag receptacles are located at the Hopkins VFW, Kraemer's True Value Hardware store in Glenn Lake area, and the Minnetonka Community Center.

This is the result of an Eagle Project done by Kris Scott. Most people know very little about the care of the flag. Searching the internet, there is very little on flag retirement, and for the average citizen, this is a difficult process. The goal of this project is to create an easier way for the community to dispose of and retire worn-out and damaged flags.
